OSAID is youth inspired leadership program whose goal is to eliminate impaired driving.

Since 1987 OSAID has had awareness-raising groups in secondary schools across every school board in Ontario. OSAID is a registered Canadian charity.

What is the Youth Advisory Team for ?

OSAID needs a team of youth to help create, promote, and host a two hour mini conference on the issues of impaired driving in your area. This conference will be used as a means to educate participants on the dangers of impaired driving and to launch a region-wide school challenge to help promote safer roads.

What would I do as a member of the Youth Advisory Team ?
